Additionally, the Value Achievement Phase encompasses the actions taken during and after the project to ensure the project benefits are realized. This phase occurs after project closeout, but the work of value achievement should start early in the project. In order for value achievement to be possible, the quantitative project benefits need to be determined during preparation of the business case, which is done during the genesis phase. In the value achievement phase, work is done to ensure all project benefits are obtained. Preliminary planning for value achievement should start at the same time project planning is being done.

Here are some preliminary plans for value achievement that should be included:

- Product and project success criteria
- Roles and responsibilities
- · Preliminary schedule and budget with resources needed
- Risk register for risk events associated with value
- Executive support

Rigor and discipline in execution and prioritization are also crucial for value realization in a project.



PMI-CP Certification covers the domains of contracts management, stakeholder management, strategy and scope management, and project governance, certifies professionals in the construction and built environment industry.

- Value Earners of the PMI-CP have demonstrated skills and knowledge they need to transform the global construction industry and bring large, complex projects to life.
- Education Requirements None
- Experience Requirements 3+ years of experience in the construction/built environment field is required
- Certification Maintenance Requirements 3-year cycle; 30 PDUs per cycle
- Course and Exam Information
  - The construction curriculum will include 7 e-learning courses, 3
    of which can earn you micro-credentials, and a capstone exam
    to earn the full PMI-CP certification.
  - Exam will be available after you complete all 7 courses, earn the 3 related micro-credentials, and have 3 years of experience in the construction/built environment field.
